New Policy: All of our parade participants are winners; therefore we will NOT be judging entries. You may call after February 19, 2010 for your line-up position, or wait to receive information at check-in the day of the parade. Line-up information will not be mailed prior to the parade.

Check-in and staging will be located at 112 E. 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, in the large dirt lot on the east side of Idaho Road, between Old West Highway & Junction. Check-in will be open 6:30 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. YOUR ENTRY MUST BE IN LINE AT 8:30 a.m.

All entries must check-in and receive their number prior to the parade.

Please note that your parade position shall be at the discretion of the parade committees as to produce the best overall performance.

## **IMPORTANT – MUST READ**

### **Lost Dutchman Days Parade 2010**

#### **Policy Statements**

Participants must read this statement and initial the Parade application acknowledging that they have read, understand and will adhere to all policies as established by the LDD Parade Committee. The Lost Dutchman Days Committee members, parade officials and parade staff, have the right to evict any entry (prior or during the parade) for any reason they deem necessary for the safety of other entrants, participants and spectators. If evicted, the parade entry fee (if applicable) will not be refunded. Any horse/animal appearing to be difficult to control, and/or any rider who appears to be unable to control their horse/animal, will be evicted from line-up and/or the parade route and must depart immediately at such time the request is made. Equine entries with rider/riders under ten (10) years of age will only be allowed participation if accompanied with an adult (over 18 years of age) as an escort, remaining at the head of the horse at all times. No entry will be allowed to access the parade line up any later than 8:30 a.m. Absolutely, NOTHING will be thrown or handed out from any parade entry to the parade audience. Walkers along the parade route can distribute products by handing them directly to individuals, but nothing can be tossed into the crowd. Offenders will be immediately evicted from the parade. Parade officials have the right to place late entries, or un-registered entries at the end of the parade. Lost Dutchman Days Parade Committee reserves the right to expel any parade participant that is argumentative, verbally abusive or harasses any committee member, staff, other parade participants or audience. Parade entrants are responsible for the conduct of their entry and liable for any injury or accident caused by their entry. Alcoholic beverages are prohibited in the parade.
